WHAT: Secure Ballot Drop-off boxes

WHERE: Rotunda of the Government Center - 669 Washington Street, Easton, PA
Human Services Building – 2801 Emrick Blvd, Bethlehem, PA
Northampton County 911 Center – 100 Gracedale Ave, Nazareth, PA
Bethlehem City Hall – 10 E. Church Street, Bethlehem, PA

WHEN: Available from October 1 until 8:00PM on November 3, 2020

The Northampton County Elections Office has installed a secure ballot drop-off box in each of the County's four districts. The boxes will be available beginning October 1, 2020 until 8:00PM on November 3, 2020. Accessing the drop-off boxes will not require going through security.

- Rotunda of the Government Center – 669 Washington Street, Easton, PA 18042
 - Monday – Friday from 8:30AM – 8:00PM
 - Saturday from 8:00AM – 12:00PM

Voters can park for free in the loading-and-unloading zone on Washington Street in front of the courthouse when they drop off their ballot or use the new parking lot at the intersection of Wolf Avenue and Washington Street.

- Human Services Building – 2801 Emrick Blvd. Bethlehem, PA 18020
 - Monday – Friday from 8:30AM – 7:00PM
- Northampton County 911 Center – 100 Gracedale Ave. Nazareth, PA 18064
 - Monday – Friday from 8:30AM – 4:30PM
- Bethlehem City Hall – 10 E. Church Street, Bethlehem, PA 18018
 - Monday – Friday from 8:00AM – 4:00PM

Voters may only drop off their own ballots. Third party return of ballots is prohibited unless the person returning the ballot is rendering assistance to a disabled voter or emergency absentee voter.

Counterfeiting, forging, tampering with or destroying ballots is a second-degree misdemeanor pursuant to sections 1816 and 1817 of the PA Election Code. (25 P.S. §§ 3516 and 3517)
