ALLEN TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, May 22, 2012

A General Meeting of the Allen Township Supervisors was held on Tuesday, May 22, 2012, at 7:00 P.M. at the Allen Township Municipal Building, 4714 Indian Trail Road, Northampton, Pennsylvania 18067. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by Vice Chairman Bruce Frack.

Public Hearings: No scheduled public hearings.

Public to be Heard: No comments from the audience.

Unfinished Business

A. Stone Ridge, developers request to discuss Phase 1B and time extension: Mr. Holmes made a motion to grant an extension of time until May 31, 2013; seconded by Mr. Frack. On the motion, by roll call vote all supervisors present voted yes.

B. Northampton Borough Sewer Litigation – request for executive session: Mr. Treadwell requested an executive session to discuss the latest Borough proposal.

New Business

A. 2012 Road Bids – permission to advertise: Mr. Holmes made a motion to authorize Ms. Eckhart to advertise for bids pursuant to the list prepared by the Public Works Director.

B. Nappa Agricultural Security Addition Request: Mr. Holmes made a motion to approve the agricultural security addition pursuant to the recommendation of the Planning Commission; seconded by Mr. Frack. On the motion, by roll call vote, all Supervisors present voted yes.

C. Savage Road Extension to Howertown Road: Mr. Frack asked the Board to consider looking into investigating the extension of the current driveway into Miller's Ace Hardware

through to Howertown Road. Mr. Treadwell indicated there is an agreement that was part of the land development plan that he will need to review and discuss with the road regarding the possible extension of the road. He will report to the Board regarding this matter.

Public to be Heard: Mr. Tift commented regarding the use of oil and chip on the roads – he asked if the Board really felt it was cost effective. No comments from the public.

The Board held a brief executive session to discuss ongoing litigation with Northampton Borough. Mr. Treadwell provided a suggested response. There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
