ALLEN TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, July 23, 2013

A General Meeting of the Allen Township Supervisors was held on Tuesday, July 23, 2013, at 7:00 P.M. at the Allen Township Municipal Building, 4714 Indian Trail Road, Northampton, Pennsylvania 18067. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by Chairman Paul Balliet.

Public Hearings: No public hearings.

Public to be Heard: No comments from the audience.

A. Riparian Buffers – Covered Bridge Property – John Mauser: Mr. John Mauser presented a brief overview of a recent stream bank stabilization and restoration project completed in part at the Township's Kreidersville Covered Bridge property. He explained a next phase of the project which is a continued effort to minimize the impact of loss of the stream bank and protection of the bridge structure. Following some comments of the Board, Mr. Pierce made a motion to allow Mr. Uhnak to work with John Mauser to acquire 3 to 5 root wads for use with the Stream Bank Restoration project proposed at the Township's Kreidersville Covered Bridge Park property; seconded by Mrs. Drzewiecki. On the motion, by roll call vote, all Supervisors present voted yes.

B. Bertsch & Hokendauqua Creek Watershed Coldwater Conservation Plan – Jim Wilson: Mr. James Wilson of the Northampton County Conservation District presented an overview of the plan. On the question from Mr. Pierce, he indicated he would follow-up with PP&L to determine if there was any funding available to restore plantings on the line clearing along the Hokendauqua Creek in the area of the Kreidersville Covered Bridge Park.

Unfinished Business

A. Road Oil and Chip Bids Received: Ms. Eckhart reviewed the bids received for the application of in-place oil and chip for 2013 for the following roads: East Bullshead Road, Lappawinzo Road, Snow Hill Road, Millrace Road and Granger Road. The total quantity equals

30,131 square yards. Mr. Holmes made a motion to approve the bid for oil and chip to Asphalt Maintenance Solutions, LLC at \$2.31 square yards for a total of \$69,602.61; seconded by Mr. Frack. On the motion, by roll call vote, all Supervisors present voted yes.
