Tuesday, May 23, 2017

A General Meeting of the Allen Township Supervisors was held on Tuesday, May 23, 2017 at 7:00 P.M. at the Allen Township Municipal Building, 4714 Indian Trail Road, Northampton, Pennsylvania 18067. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by Chairman Larry Oberly.

Unfinished Business

A. Conditional Offer of Employment – A. Radford: Mr. Behler made a motion to hire A. Radford subject to the satisfaction of the conditional offer of employment dated May 16, 2017; seconded by Mr. Frack. On the motion, by roll call vote, all Supervisors present voted yes.

B. Dashuta Land Development Plan – Planning Items for Board Concurrence/Discussion: Mr. Hassler made a motion to approve the concept to approve based on Mr. Cox’s scenario; seconded by Mr. Frack. On the motion, by roll call vote, all Supervisors voted yes.

C. Road Bids Received May 22, 2017:

i. Church Road – Double Bituminous Seal Coat: Mr. Behler made a motion to award to AMS in the amount of \$26,971.85; seconded by Mr. Hassler. On the motion, by roll call vote, all Supervisors present voted yes.

ii. Farm Hill Road – Double Bituminous Seal Coat: Mr. Hassler made a motion to award to AMS in the amount of \$28,495.82; seconded by Mr. Frack. On the motion, by roll call vote, all Supervisors present voted yes.

iii. Kohls Road – Double Bituminous Seal Coat: Mr. Pierce made a motion to award to AMS in the amount of \$21,287.20; seconded by Mr. Behler. On the motion, by roll call vote, all Supervisors present voted yes.

D. Garage Security Updates: Mr. Behler made a motion to approve the quote from Altronics for security monitoring and security cameras for the garage and the monitor for the front office at a cost of \$2550.00; seconded by Mr. Frack. On the motion, by roll call vote, all Supervisors present voted yes.

New Business

- A. **Dry Run Detention Basin Retrofit and Planting Concepts:** Ms. Eckhart discussed Planting Concepts for the Dry Run Detention Basin and recommendations from Edge of the Woods Nursery. Ms. Eckhart will return with quantity of seed required for a late fall planting. This was also included in the Township MS4 reporting.
- B. **Ron Del at Hampton Ridge Reverse Subdivision:** Tabled for the June 8, 2017 meeting.
- C. **PennDOT Request Detour Indian Trail Road Bridge Repair:** Ms. Eckhart stated the work is scheduled for June 2017 and requested 2 detours for the Bridge Repair. One detour would be Kohls Road and the other is Walnut Drive in Lehigh Township that loops around. Mr. Hassler suggested that Kohls Road be local traffic only and should not allow trucks and heavy traffic on that road. Mr. Frack made a motion to accept the option of Walnut Drive as the detour; seconded by Mr. Hassler. On the motion, by roll call vote, all Supervisors present voted yes.
