ALLEN TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, April 24, 2012

A General Meeting of the Allen Township Supervisors was held on Tuesday, April 24, 2012, at 7:00 P.M. at the Allen Township Municipal Building, 4714 Indian Trail Road, Northampton, Pennsylvania 18067. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by Chairman Paul Balliet.

Unfinished Business

A. Municipal Building Roof Replacement, review of bids received: Ms. Eckhart read aloud the bids received as follows:
