ALLEN TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, August 28, 2012

A General Meeting of the Allen Township Supervisors was held on Tuesday, August 28, 2012, at 7:00 P.M. at the Allen Township Municipal Building, 4714 Indian Trail Road, Northampton, Pennsylvania 18067. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by Chairman Paul Balliet.

Public Hearings: No public hearings.

Public to be Heard: No comments from the audience.

Unfinished Business

New Business

A. Krause – request for waiver of well separation distance – 58 Old Carriage Road: Mr. Everett Doult was present to request the Board’s consideration to grant a waiver of the required well isolation distance exemption pursuant to DEP Chapter 72 regulations. He indicated that the existing septic system is not currently in failure – although the existing house is currently unoccupied. Mr. Mack indicated that in order to consider the waiver a ground water study would need to be submitted and payment of fees and costs incurred by the Township to review the groundwater study would be required. In addition if a repair to a malfunctioning on lot system is considered (which this property is currently not exhibiting malfunction), under Chapter 72, the groundwater study and fees may be waived by the Township.

If a new septic system is installed Mr. Doutt indicated that the well would be approximately currently 60 feet in distance from the new system. He indicated he would move the well if necessary to obtain the waiver.

Following some discussion, the Board suggested Mr. Doutt determine if a groundwater study has been prepared by PNC bank. In addition, the Board did not consider the waiver further due to the system not exhibiting a current malfunction.

Public to be Heard: There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
